1	School cloak set with monogram.	White Aseel Radium kurtha with collar available from I.G. Hoosen. School Monogram is <b>COMPULSORY</b> to be sewn onto the blazer and kurtha pocket <b>OR</b> White school shirt, grey school pants, school tie with compulsory logo and blazer with school monogram.
2	Black or Navy inner, preferably navy.	Plain white vest <b>or</b> plain white T-shirt. Strictly no printed or coloured t-shirts underneath the kurtha.
3	Navy school scarf with monogram Navy head band is <b>COMPULSORY</b>	White topee, available from GEM stores for all boys will be compulsory.  No other white topee's permitted.
4	Navy school blazer + iron-on monogram ( <b>COMPULSORY</b> )	Navy school blazer + iron-on monogram ( <b>COMPULSORY</b> )
5	Black School Shoes	Black school shoes
6	Black School Socks NO colours (at the toe-end or at heels) Strictly no anklets or tennis socks.	Plain Grey regulation school socks. NO colours (at the toe-end or at heels) Strictly no anklets or tennis socks.
7	P.E/SPORTS KIT.  Navy school track pants Navy school T-shirt with monogram.  Black trainers.  Headgear: Navy bandana / Mini Burka	P.E/SPORTS KIT.  Navy school track pants to be worn <b>ONLY</b> for P.E. <b>and not to be substituted</b> for grey pants on P.E. days.  Navy school T-shirt with monogram <b>ONLY</b> for PE/Sports. Not allowed to be worn under kurtha.  Black trainers.  School peak caps -optional.
8	Senior school bag- <b>COMPULSORY</b>	Senior School Bag – <b>COMPULSORY</b>
9	Navy V-neck jersey is <b>OPTIONAL</b> but does <b>NOT</b> replace <b>BLAZER</b>	Navy V-neck jersey is <b>OPTIONAL</b> but does <b>NOT</b> replace <b>BLAZER</b>
10	Hair: to be completely covered. No tinted or coloured hair. No learner is to wear a "high bun" or any accessories.	Hair: short hair style of uniform length, no.2 cut. No stepped hair styles are permitted. Hair should not fall over eyes, ears or collar. No gel spikes, wedges or tinting allowed. Refer to code of conduct.

### **ADDITIONAL NOTES**

- I.G. Hoosen is the preferred supplier of the school kurthas. All other articles of uniform may be purchased from GEM Schoolwear (unless otherwise indicated).
- Kurthas to be in plain fabric, no self-patterned (stripes etc) – all to have a Chinese collar.
- The School blazer is a compulsory requirement of the school uniform throughout the year. Blazers are to be taken home every day and worn upon entering and exiting the school premises **DAILY**. The school will not be held liable for any blazer left at school.
- **ONLY ORIENT SCHOOL BAGS WILL BE ALLOWED.** Learners will **NOT** be allowed at school without the prescribed bag.
- Lunch and qur'an bags may be purchased from the school tuckshop.
- All female learners must adhere strictly to the dress code, especially the wearing of the scarf. Hair must be tied at the nape of the neck ensuring a neat and standardized look. The head-band for the girls is **COMPULSORY**.
- A mini (short) burkha is **COMPULSORY** during P.E and all other sport activities.
- No make-up or anything that constitutes make-up is allowed (coloured lip gloss /tinted sunblock etc.)
- No jewellery, except a simple wristwatch (no coloured / fancy bands). Stud earrings are allowed for female females only.
- Female learners are not allowed to colour their hair. Pink and other colours / blond / streaks of different shades etc - this is also in keeping with Shariah principles.
- Boys **MUST** adhere to the school rules with regard to haircuts. A short school haircut only is permitted.**NO STEPPED** haircuts (shaved sides, long centers) are allowed. This is in keeping with Shariah principles.
- All learners shall show pride in their school by ensuring that they are neatly attired in the prescribed uniform.
- The prescribed uniform must be worn at all times during normal school activity, including week-ends and school holidays, when attending school programmes, activities, functions and / or excursions, except where such requirements are specifically exempted by the School management.
- Full school uniform must be worn after every sports practice.
- Please note that non-compliance with the dress code will constitute a uniform infringement as per the code of conduct and will result in a learner being sent home and issued with demerits. Hence, we urge parents to ensure that learners leave home in the correct school attire.
